PACKAGING REQUIREMENTS.

☐ CARGO LINER

- 2 x 390 mm 30mm wide selfadhesive loop fastener
- 11 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener
- 12 x (ref.113)tabs Frequent use hook & loop fastener



• 22 x tabs self-adhesive loop fastener

VERY IMPORTANT PREPARATION



To ensure the self-adhesive hook & loop fastener stick to the plastic trim, you **MUST CLEAN** all grime from the plastic and **REMOVE** all **SILICONE** applied during manufacture and detailing.

To do this please:

- 1. Use a silicone remover, such as AutoGlym Intensive Tar Remover and apply generously to the surface you want to adhere to.
- 2. Using a separate clean & dry cloth, thoroughly dry the surface until the cloth starts to drag. Attach one selfadhesive fastener tab to see if it sticks. (Repeat steps 1 to 2 if necessary) Extra tabs have been provided.
- 3. Attach the self-adhesive fasteners and let them fully adhere over the next 24 hours for the best bond.



*The self-adhesive fasteners cannot be used once they have been in contact with silicone. Replacement kits are available on our website.





STEP I. PREPARATIONS

Remove the cargo cover. It may be replaced later.



STEP 2. FITTING THE BASE

• Place the Cargo liner into the cargo area with the Hatchbag logo at the seat end. Flatten the base so it fits snugly against the edges. The hook fasteners on the back side attch directly to the carpet. (Image B)



STEP 3. FITTING THE FRONT

- PLUS / SPLIT VERSION ONLY Fasten the hook & loop fasteners between the side panels and the seat panel. (Image C)
- Starting with the middle headrest, fasten the hook & loop fastener straps around both headrest posts. (Image D). Make sure to hold the front part of the base in position to avoid pulling the Cargo liner too far up. Repeat the procedure with the left and right headrests.




You MUST unfasten the hook & loop fasteners and the headrest straps before you recline the upper parts of the rear seats. (*Please refer to REAR PLUS / SPLIT options on website to see detailed photo*)





STEP 4. FITTING THE SIDES

- If you frequently remove/fit your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle please note that the carpet will "fluff" up. We provide you with 12 x tabs (ref 113) Frequent use hook & loop fasteners. Place 6 frequent use tabs on the top edge of each side panel. (Image E)
- Fasten the hook fastener on the top edge of side of the Cargo liner on the top edge of the carpeted sides of the cargo area. (Or onto the *Frequent use hook & loop fastener (ref 113)* previously placed) (Image F)





FITTING THE BACK

- Stick one self-adhesive fastener tab to the inside center of the back panel, aligned with the hook fastener on the back panel of the Cargo liner. (white arrow Image H). The floor lifting loop will need to be tucked under the base panel of the liner.
- Stick the two 390mm self adhesive loop fastener strips on the tailgate edge of the cargo area starting from the lock in the middle running along the panel, (highlighted in blueimage G). Snip the self-adhesive fastener strips in the corners to ease around the curve.
- Stick 5 self-adhesive fastener tabs on either side of the back panel, aligned with the hook fastener on the side panels of the Cargo liner. (highlighted in orange Image G)
- Fasten the Cargo liner to them using the hook fastener on the liner. (Image I)







OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Please note the following photos are not specific to your vehicle

STEP 5A. LIFTGATE COVER

- Line up the liftgate cover with the liftgate and clean the areas where the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs will be stuck. (Image 4)
- Use the self-adhesive loop fastener tabs to attach the cover to the plastic trim.

STEP 5C. BUMPER FLAP

- Install Cago liner
- Attach the Bumper Flap to the loop fastener strip located at the base of the boot liner.

 (Image 5)
- The Bumper Flap either folds into the vehicle OR can be detached and stored elsewhere when you close the liftgate.

STEP 5C. CARGO LINER EXTENSION

The Cargo Liner Extension provides superior protection to the rear seats when purchased with a REAR PLUS option. (Image 3)

- The Cargo Liner Extension is designed to attach to a Rear Plus version liner.
- It provides additional protection to the back of the front seats and the extended floor area when the rear seats are folded flat.
- It does not offer full protection to the rear doors.



The Bumper Flap and the Cargo Liner Extension cannot be added at a later date.

STEP 5D. FREQUENT USE INSTALLATION KIT

• If you frequently remove/install your Cargo liner from/to your vehicle, please note that the carpet will "fluff" up. We offer an alternative Frequent Use Installation Kit (Image 4 & 5
